○ = Mandatory items for each Star Rank. You must complete all circled items.

Listed below is the minimum number required for each color rank.

<u>WHITE</u>	= 10
<u>RED</u>	= 12
<u>BLUE</u>	= 14
<u>GOLD</u>	= 16

Each line is one requirement.

1. There are 5 ranks in the 4-H Star Rank Program:
The 1st 4 are White, Red, Blue, and Gold. The 5th level is All Star which is available to 4-H'ers who have earned a gold star.
2. The Star Rank Form is a cumulative record. As you participate in more activities you can advance to the next rank. Your permanent record is the best way to track your activities.
3. At the end of the 4-H year complete your 4-H Permanent Record first. The corresponding permanent record page number is listed after each activity. Count and enter the total for each activity into the column titled TOTAL ALL YEARS.
4. To qualify for a Star Rank you must complete each activity the number of times listed under "requirements for".
5. Member and Parent/Guardian must both sign on the back of this page before submitting the form for award consideration.
6. To receive the 4-H Star Rank Award you must fill out the Star Rank Award Application (this form). You may submit your 4-H Star Rank Award Application in either of the ways listed here. **A:** If you complete a 4-H Record Book, place the 4-H Star Rank Award Application in a business envelope (#10) and tape to inside front cover of the Acco-type folder. **B:** If you do not complete a 4-H Record Book, put your permanent record in an Acco-type folder and the Star Rank Application in an envelope taped in the front cover and submit. The Star Rank Award Application is due at the time the Record Book is due.
7. You can receive each color rank only once.
